
## The Story of Waverly Road Presbyterian Church— (taken from Be Thou My Vision revised edition by Keene White)



On Maundy Thursday in 1989 the congregation took part in a Seder meal as observed by the Jewish community during Passover as apart of our Lenten season activities. With our beloved friend Phil Hamer, an amateur and sincere student of Judaism directing, we got a new appreciation for the events of Jesus' last evening with his disciples and our observance of the

sacrament of the Lord's Supper immediately after was especially meaningful.

On June 18, 1989, the first house which our congregation completed under a covenant agreement with Habitat for Humanity was dedicated and the Housewright family proudly became owners of the property. In addition, this was the beginning of a pleasant association with a remarkable family. It was noted that substantially all of the money needed for this house was pledged in one day during a family lunch after the morning worship service.

# Just a few reminders while you are at the church....

#### **The Church Office Entrance Door**

# **French Dip Sliders**

Don't be fooled by their size, these little guys pack major flavor.

Yields: 12

## **Ingredients**

- 5 tbsp. butter, divided
- 1 large onion, thinly sliced
- 2 sprigs, plus 1/4 teaspoon fresh thyme
- Kosher salt
- Freshly ground black pepper
- 12 slider buns, halved
- 1 lb. thinly sliced deli roast beef
- 12 slices provolone cheese
- 1/4 tsp. garlic powder
- 1 tbsp. clove garlic, minced
- 11/2 c. low-sodium beef broth
- 1 tbsp. Worcestershire sauce

## **Directions**

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°. In a large skillet over mediumhigh heat, melt 2 tablespoons butter. Add onion and thyme sprigs and season with salt and pepper. Cook, stirring occasionally, until caramelized, about 15 minutes. Discard thyme.
- Place bottom halves of slider buns on a large baking sheet and top with roast beef, provolone cheese, caramelized onions, and slider bun tops.
- 3. Melt 2 tablespoons butter and brush on top of buns. Sprinkle with garlic powder, coarse salt, and parsley and bake until cheese is melty and sliders are warmed through, 10 to 15 minutes.
- 4. Meanwhile, make au jus: Add remaining 1 tablespoon butter to same skillet and melt over medium heat. Add garlic and cook until fragrant, 1 minute, then add beef broth, Worcestershire, and thyme and season with salt and pepper. Simmer until slightly reduced, 10 minutes.
- 5. Serve sliders with au jus for dipping.
