Greetings to you in the name of our Lord, Jesus Christ,

I am working from Holston Camp this week where I am serving as the chaplain. Being at camp is such a great experience, but it is one that can get me into trouble. Preaching to these kids is amazing, but I also have to make the stories come alive in not so 'churchy' ways.

For instance, this morning I told the kids that our God likes to party!! We read the story of the lost sheep. When I asked them what happened when the shepherd brought the sheep back they used the word 'celebration' and I told them it was party time. They really liked that.

I used those words in church once and was lovingly taken to task for calling Jesus a 'party animal,' a criticism that was often thrown at Jesus in scripture. Something about using those words with kids opens them up to ways of experiencing God in a way that they may not in church.

Maybe we should all get up to camp and experience God in a new way.

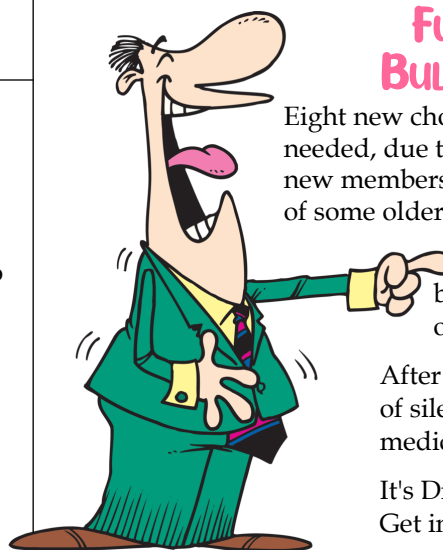
Funny Church Bulletin Bloopers

No-Bake Berry Tiramisu

Ingredients

- 20 to 30 store-bought ladyfingers
- 1¼ cups heavy cream
- 1 cup granulated sugar, divided
- ¾ cup ricotta cheese
- ⅓ cup cream cheese
- 1 tablespoon lemon zest
- Pinch of cinnamon
- 1½ teaspoons pure vanilla extract
- ¼ teaspoon pure almond extract (optional)
- ¾ cup seedless raspberry jam or jelly
- 2 cups sliced strawberries
- 1½ cups raspberries
- 1 cup blackberries
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice



Directions

1. Arrange half of the ladyfingers in an even layer in the base of a 9-by-13-inch pan.
2. In the bowl of an electric mixer fitted with the whipping attachment, whip the cream with ¾ cup sugar until the mixture forms soft peaks. Add the ricotta, cream cheese, lemon zest, cinnamon, vanilla extract and almond extract (if using) and whip until medium peaks form.
3. Pour half of the cream mixture over the ladyfingers and spread into an even layer with a spatula. Spread the jam on top of the cream in an even layer.
4. Arrange the remaining ladyfingers on top of the jam in an even layer. Top with the remaining cream mixture.
5. In a medium bowl, toss the strawberries, raspberries and blackberries with the lemon juice to combine. Add the remaining ¼ cup sugar and mix well.
6. Pour the berry mixture in an even layer on top of the cream. Chill for 1 hour (or up to overnight) to soften the ladyfingers before serving.
