
## **Vocal Scholarship**

## L BENEDICTION RESPONSE

DISCIPLESHIP AND MISSION



Written by a nineteen-year-old in Connecticut, this challenging text has been widely printed on both sides of the Atlantic. It is strengthened by its resolute repetition of the same four words at the beginning of each stanza and by the appropriately stark shape note tune.



call on your name; you are my God, and your bless-ing I claim. all the op-pressed; hear us, O God! Let your peo-ple be blessed.

This text does not paraphrase any specific psalm, but it adopts the vocabulary and the structure of many psalms. The first two stanzas begin with a sense of abandonment and despair, which is countered by remembrance of God's nature. This memory leads to a final stanza of praise.
