

Mission Moment Update ...

Food Pantry Update October 29, 2023

For those of you who do not know, I am the Director of the Waverly Road Food Pantry; When I last reported to you, I started with a quote from Feeding America:

"It's a problem no one should have to face".

Nine words that sum up the issue of hunger, both across America, and in our own back yard.

As we complete our 40th year of operation, the Waverly Road Food Pantry continues to play a part in addressing the hunger issue in our community. To date in 2023, we delivered 1604 bags of food, a 4.5% increase over the same period for 2022.

Our partnership with Second Harvest Food Bank of Northeast Tennessee helps not only our Food Pantry but allows us to help support other community efforts. In particular, I want to highlight Project Thanksgiving, which will be coming up in a few weeks. During November each year, the Waverly Road Presbyterian Church Food Pantry partners with Christian Radio WCQR-FM 88.3 and Second Harvest Food Bank of Northeast Tennessee to offer Thanksgiving meals to families in need. The boxes of food offered to us are distributed through the Kingsport City Schools Homeless Education Program and Family Resource Center to families they serve. Thanks to the generosity of our congregation, through both direct gifts, memorial contributions and the Christmas Card Project (more on that in the coming weeks), we are in a strong financial position. Consequently, we have not had to request any funding from the Mission Action Plan, allowing those funds to be directed towards other worthy projects.

At a recent meeting of the United Way's Hunger Task Force, it was noted that 1 in 7 Tennesseans have food security issues. That's more than 1 million people. The need is still with us, which is why we need to continue to be "The Hands of Christ on Waverly Road".

Cornbread and Sage Dressing Balls

Cornbread and sage come together with other classic flavors for a moist holiday dressing everyone will love.

Servings: 12 balls

Ingredients

4 cups crumbled cornbread crumble it and then measure

4 slices white bread torn into 1-inch pieces

3/4 cup diced celery

1/2 cup diced onion

1 egg

1/2 stick melted butter

21/2 teaspoons ground sage

1/2 teaspoon salt

1/4 teaspoon black pepper

1 cup chicken broth 12 ounces, you can add a bit more if your mix seems dry

Directions

- 1. Preheat the oven to 350.
- 2. In a large bowl mix all the ingredients except the broth and toss well.
- 3. Add the broth and mix. If it seems dry, add a little more. Dressing should be wet but not have standing liquid in the bottom.
- 4. Form baseball size balls or spread in a greased 8×8 baking dish and bake 20-25 minutes until heated through and lightly brown on the top.
