

# **Sunday School for Children & Youth**

### **Nursery available for Children—0-3 Years**

#### Sundays from 9:30am—12:30pm

Located in the Caterpillar Room, which is open and staffed with loving caregivers on Sunday mornings from 9:30am until the end of the worship service. It is accessible through the main church entrance, located near the sanctuary. The staff provides consistency for the children and maintains our high standards of health and safety, as well as a low teacher/child ratio.



#### **Kindergarten Sunday School—3 years**

For children ages three through Kindergarten. This class is located in the Godly Play Room, Room 102.

In this class we use a Montessori-based approach to learning Bible stories using special crafts and activities. The program is designed to enable young children to encounter God by using both their critical "gates" of interaction: play and language. Its intent is to invite children to experience God's presence as real and gracious.



# Sunday School for 1st—2nd Grade

The 1st and 2nd Grade Sunday School
Class follows the Feasting on the
Word Curriculum. This curriculum



presents focus scriptures from the Revised Common Lectionary. These young learners are presented with age-appropriate activities that enable them to explore God's Word and grow in their understanding not only of scripture and biblical stories, but of worship and service to God. This is a welcoming and friendly class that works together to have fun while learning how to put God's Word into actions!

#### Sunday School for 3-5th Grade

Each Sunday a scripture passage is presented. Children and leaders experience a series of activities designed to explore that passage and apply it to their lives. The class meets at 9:15 am on Sunday mornings (earlier than other classes).
