Mission Moment Update ... November 10, 2024 / **Food Pantry Christmas Cards**

One of our traditions at Waverly Road Presbyterian Church began 31 years ago. The first Food Pantry Christmas Cards were designed and decorated by our elementary-aged children in 1993.

More than \$161,000 has been donated over the history of our Christmas Card Project and year-end giving to the Food Pantry. We did not keep track of the total amount donated early in the program, so we know the grand total is actually higher.

Last December, 117 Food Pantry Christmas Cards were requested and sent to family and friends close to home and far away.

When you donate to our Food Pantry through Monday, December 16th, a 2024 special edition Christmas card will be sent to the person(s) of your choice.

You may wish to use the card to send Christmas greetings, or you may use it to honor or remember someone special.

Order forms are located on the table in the Narthex and in the church workroom. You may also contact Susan and she will send the information to you.

Year-end special gifts are also welcome. Donations to our Food Pantry will gladly be accepted through the end of December. Please let me know if you would like an acknowledgment for tax purposes.

Along with end-of-year contributions in 2023, our Food Pantry received \$5,505, which helped enable us to continue feeding our neighbors this year.

Many of our neighbors in this community need food assistance and your donation will help provide for them in the coming months.

A Great Way You Can Help a Hurting Friend



Do you have a friend, neighbor, co-worker, or relative who is going through a difficult time? Here's a great way you can help them – tell them about our Stephen Ministry! Stephen Ministers

are members of Waverly Road Presbyterian Church who have received special training to provide high-quality, confidential, one-to-one, Christian care to people who are grieving the loss of a loved one, coping with a cancer diagnosis, going through a divorce or separation, battling a chronic illness (or caring for a spouse or parent who is chronically ill), experiencing a great deal of stress, facing the loss of a job – or encountering any of countless other life transitions.

Stephen Ministers meet weekly with their care receivers to listen, care, encourage, and provide emotional and spiritual support. (Males are matched with males, and females are matched with females.) The caring relationship lasts for as long as the person needs care. It's free, and it's a powerful way you can help a hurting friend.

We are planning a time of Reflection, Fellowship, and Food with friends on Saturday, December 21, which is the longest night of the year. It is sometimes called Blue Christmas. Everyone is invited to attend. If someone would like to attend and prefers not to drive after dark, we will come and pick you up. Please let one of the Stephen Leaders know by November 21st if you are interested in attending.


We're on the Lookout for Small Group Ideas!
